What Peace Means

also signifies prosperity, well-being in general, all good in relation to both man and God. (Psalm 122:7; Psalm 35:27; Psalm 73:3; 2 Samuel 11:7; Luke 19:42; Luke 1:74, 79; Luke 12:51). Peace is incomplete if it is one-sided. Perfect peace starts with having peace with God. He who is not at peace with God cannot have peace with humans. How then can one have peace with God?

Jesus The Prince of Peace

In John 14:6 Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." The way to have peace with God and be at peace with fellow humans is to accept Jesus Christ as savior and Lord. He is The Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6). His birth brought peace to humanity (Luke 2:14). He was born to proclaim peace to the nations (Zechariah 9:10). The Spirit of the Lord was upon him to minister peace to the world (Luke 4:18-19). Jesus was born to bring man into a peaceful relationship with God which translates to having peace with fellow humans.
